

Cystic fibrosis (CF) is the most common, fatal genetic disease affecting Canadian children and young adults. There is no cure.

- It is a multi-system disease that affects mainly the lungs and the digestive system.
- Every week in Canada, one person dies from cystic fibrosis.
- Two more babies are diagnosed with cystic fibrosis every week.
- Cumulatively, Canadians with cystic fibrosis spent almost 20,000 days in hospital and attended over 15,000 clinic visits in 2012.
- Ultimately, most deaths related to cystic fibrosis are due to lung disease.

Together with Kin Canada, we have set our sights squarely on finding a cure.

In 1960, most children with cystic fibrosis did not live long enough to attend kindergarten.

Today, because of the support of Kin members and other generous donors, half of all Canadians with cystic fibrosis are expected to live into their 40s and beyond.
